BOOKING TICKETS

Tickets are booked through the Beverley Tourist Information Service. The best ways to book are:

- * By post. Send your completed booking form (please fill in your name and address on the form), along with a cheque payable to ERYC, and a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
- * In person. Beverley TIC is open Monday to Friday from 9.30 to 5.15, Saturday from 10.00 to 4.45, Sunday from 11.00 to 3.00 (July and August). You can pay by card, cash or cheque. Again, please fill in your name and address on the booking form.

You can also book by phone, using the number 01482 391672. Phone bookings incur an additional £1 charge to cover administration.

All seats are numbered, and the staff in the TIC will help you choose the best seats available in each price area. Some seats in the side aisles have a restricted view of the stage and performers. If the seat you are in has a poor view on the night, we will help you find a better one, providing there are seats available.

Once the Festival is under way, all the tickets are kept at St Mary's Church (or the Minster, on Saturday). We sell tickets for half an hour before each concert begins, and you can purchase tickets for any concert during this time.
